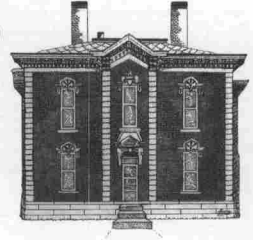

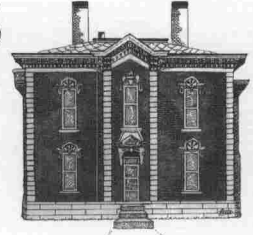

Resolution # 04-13-09-1

A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE SURFACE APPLICATION OF BRINE TO ROADS, STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND OTHER SIMILAR SURFACES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 1509 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

The County Board of Commissioners of Holmes County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 13th day of April, 2009 and Mr. Ault moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:


WHEREAS, this Board deems it to be in the best interest of the general public to approve the a permit for the surface application of brine to **Paint Township, Winesburg, Ohio, 44690, Paint Township, Holmes County, Ohio for application to apply brine to Township roads for dust control** pursuant to Chapter 1509 of the Revised Code; and; and

WHEREAS, this Board has responsibility for regulating the spreading of brine on surfaces located in Holmes County and owned by private individuals;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the surface application of brine shall be subject to the following standards:
 - a) "Brine" shall mean all saline geological formation water resulting, obtained, or produced in connection with the expiration, drilling, or producing of oil or gas.
 - b) Surface application of brine is permitted only for the purposes of dust or ice control.
 - c) Brine shall not be applied:
 - i) To a water-saturated surface;
 - ii) Directly to vegetation near or adjacent to surfaces being treated;
 - iii) Within twelve feet of structures crossing bodies of water or crossing drainage ditches;
 - iv) Between sundown and sunrise, except for ice control.
 - d) The discharge of brine through the spreader bar shall stop when the application stops.


- e) The applicator vehicle shall be moving at least five miles per hour at all times while the brine is being applied. The maximum spreader bar nozzle opening shall be three-eighths of an inch in diameter.
 - f) The maximum uniform application rate of brine shall be three thousand gallons per mile on a twelve-foot wide road or three gallons per sixty square feet on unpaved lots.
 - g) The applicator vehicle discharge valve shall be closed between the brine collection point and the specific surfaces that have been approved for brine application.
 - h) Any valves that provide for tank drainage other than through the spreader bar shall be closed during the brine application and transport.
 - i) The angle of discharge from the applicator vehicle spreader bar shall not be greater than sixty degrees from the perpendicular to the unpaved surface.
 - j) Only the last twenty-five percent of an applicator vehicle's contents shall be allowed to have a pressure greater than atmospheric pressure; therefore, the first seventy-five percent of the applicator vehicle's contents shall be discharged under atmospheric pressure.
 - k) Application will take place **as needed for dust control**.
2. A condition of the permit is that **Paint Township**, on or before the 15th day of April for each year this permit remains in effect, must submit a yearly report with the following information:
- a) The quantities of brine transported.
 - b) The source and application point.
3. This Resolution shall be effective for one year following the date of its adoption, unless revoked.
4. Brine shall be furnished, transported and applied by: ^{Ted Keys} ~~G & C Enterprise~~ U.I.C. # 374, from wells owned and / or operated by.

A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE SURFACE APPLICATION OF BRINE TO ROADS, STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND OTHER SIMILAR SURFACES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 1509 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

The County Board of Commissioners of Holmes County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 17th day of **September, 2007** and Mr. *Hall* moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, this Board deems it to be in the best interest of the general public to approve the a permit for the surface application of brine to **Paint Township, Winesburg, Ohio, 44690, Paint Township, Holmes County, Ohio for application to apply brine to Township roads for dust control** pursuant to Chapter 1509 of the Revised Code; and;
and

WHEREAS, this Board has responsibility for regulating the spreading of brine on surfaces located in Holmes County and owned by private individuals;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the surface application of brine shall be subject to the following standards:
 - a) "Brine" shall mean all saline geological formation water resulting, obtained, or produced in connection with the expiration, drilling, or producing of oil or gas.
 - b) Surface application of brine is permitted only for the purposes of dust or ice control.
 - c) Brine shall not be applied:
 - i) To a water-saturated surface;
 - ii) Directly to vegetation near or adjacent to surfaces being treated;
 - iii) Within twelve feet of structures crossing bodies of water or crossing drainage ditches;
 - iv) Between sundown and sunrise, except for ice control.
 - d) The discharge of brine through the spreader bar shall stop when the application stops.


- e) The applicator vehicle shall be moving at least five miles per hour at all times while the brine is being applied. The maximum spreader bar nozzle opening shall be three-eighths of an inch in diameter.
 - f) The maximum uniform application rate of brine shall be three thousand gallons per mile on a twelve-foot wide road or three gallons per sixty square feet on unpaved lots.
 - g) The applicator vehicle discharge valve shall be closed between the brine collection point and the specific surfaces that have been approved for brine application.
 - h) Any valves that provide for tank drainage other than through the spreader bar shall be closed during the brine application and transport.
 - i) The angle of discharge from the applicator vehicle spreader bar shall not be greater than sixty degrees from the perpendicular to the unpaved surface.
 - j) Only the last twenty-five percent of an applicator vehicle's contents shall be allowed to have a pressure greater than atmospheric pressure; therefore, the first seventy-five percent of the applicator vehicle's contents shall be discharged under atmospheric pressure.
 - k) Application will take place **as needed for dust control**.
2. A condition of the permit is that **Paint Township**, on or before the 15th day of April for each year this permit remains in effect, must submit a yearly report with the following information:
- a) The quantities of brine transported.
 - b) The source and application point.
3. This Resolution shall be effective for one year following the date of its adoption, unless revoked.
4. Brine shall be furnished, transported and applied by: **Lake Region Oil U.I.C. # 79**, from wells owned and / or operated by.

and MR. Tim Hershberger moved for the adoption of the following
Resolution:

WHEREAS, this Board has responsibility for dust and ice control
on roads, streets, highways or other similar land surfaces owned or
controlled by the Township; and
(County or Township)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the surface application of brine shall be subject to
the following standards:

A. "Brine" shall mean all saline geological formation
water resulting, obtained, or produced in connection
with the exploration, drilling, or production of oil
or gas.

B. Surface application of brine is permitted only for the
purposes of dust or ice control.

C. Brine shall not be applied:

- I. To a water-saturated surface;
- II. Directly to vegetation near or adjacent to
surfaces being treated;
- III. Within twelve feet of structures crossing bodies
of water or crossing drainage ditches;
- IV. Between sundown and sunrise, except for ice
control.

2 D. The discharge of brine through the spreader bar shall
stop when the application stops.



- 3 E. The applicator vehicle shall be moving at least five miles per hour at all times while the brine is being applied.
- 4 F. The maximum spreader bar nozzle opening shall be three-eighths of an inch in diameter.
- 5 G. The maximum uniform application rate of brine shall be three thousand gallons per mile on a twelve foot wide road or three gallons per sixty square feet on unpaved lots;
- 6 H. The applicator vehicle discharge valve shall be closed between the brine collection point and the specific surfaces that have been approved for brine application.
- 7 I. Any valves that provide for tank drainage other than through the spreader bar shall be closed during the brine application and transport.
- 8 J. The angle of discharge from the applicator vehicle spreader bar shall not be greater than sixty degrees from the perpendicular to the unpaved surface.
- 9 K. Only the last twenty-five percent of an applicator vehicle's contents shall be allowed to have a pressure greater than atmospheric pressure; therefore, the first seventy-five percent of the applicator vehicle's contents shall be discharged under atmospheric pressure.

2. That this Board shall designate Mr Galen Troyer to be the authorized representative of this Board, with full authority to contract with individuals or entities for the application of brine to the roads, streets, highways or other similar land surfaces owned or controlled by this Paint Township, for the purposes of dust and ice control, (County or Township) provided that such contracts shall designate the roads, streets, highways or other similar land surfaces or portions thereof upon which each individual or entity may apply brine and further provided that all such contracts shall be subject to and incorporate by reference the guidelines stated in paragraph number one (1) above.

3. That this Resolution shall be effective for one year following the date of its adoption and from month to month thereafter until terminated by a subsequent resolution.
