Resolution No. **65-2017**

A resolution advising the Ohio Department of Natural Resources about the termination of the City of Euclid's use of salt brine on streets maintained by the City.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) requires annual reporting of the amount of salt brine used; and

WHEREAS, the ODNR also requires the City to submit a resolution with its 2017 Surface Application Report Form indicating the Council of the City of Euclid's support of the termination of the City's use of salt brine; and

WHEREAS, the City of Euclid has not used salt brine in the last several years as the City has been using ClearLane salt which stays on the road surface longer; and

WHEREAS, the City of Euclid discontinued the use of salt brine several years ago as it required specialized equipment that was expensive to maintain.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this resolution advises the Ohio Department of Natural Resources about the termination of the City of Euclid's use of salt brine on streets maintained by the City.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take immediate effect.
