

Mr. Brown:

I am returning the Surface Application Annual Report Form 15. However, I am not sure why the Richland County Board of Commissioners would be receiving this report to fill out.

I did research our records and found two old resolutions for brine application. November 7, 2000 the Richland County Engineer was authorized to apply liquid brine to roads to assist with ice control. The Richland County Engineer makes their own brine and applies it as needed to all of our 347 miles of roads in the County.

June 17, 2003 the Richland County Fairgrounds asked for permission to apply brine to the horse racetrack. The Fairgrounds has stated they do not currently apply brine to the racetrack and do not believe they ever have.

- Item III Hauler's Name and Registration Number must be listed if a hauler delivered or applied brine. If the county, township, or municipality used its own vehicles to apply brine, a Registration Number is not needed.
- Item IV Supply requested information for each point from which brine was collected and eventually used for surface application.
